

# SASB Honorific Award Nominations

Nominations open, closing 30 August 2024

## Early Career Research Excellence Award (ECREA)

This **annual** award will be for researchers who are members of the SASB, and who are <8 years post-Ph.D. in the calendar year of their nomination (NB. <u>Ph.D. students who have not been awarded their degree will not be considered</u>). This honorific award will be judged on performance relative to timeframe/opportunity.

# Mid-Career Research Excellence Award (MCREA)

This **annual** award will be for researchers who are members of the SASB, and who are 8–15 years post-Ph.D. in the calendar year of their nomination. This honorific award is to be judged on performance relative to timeframe/opportunity.

#### **Eliaibility**

All non-student professional members of the Society are eligible to be nominated, excluding current members of the SASB Council.

## **Nominations**

Nominators must address all the selection criteria listed below. Relevant career interruptions such as illness, caring responsibilities, or COVID-19 related career delays should be outlined clearly.

All applications should be emailed before 11:59 pm AEST **on 30 August 2024** to the current Secretary (<u>SASBiologists@gmail.com</u>). Late applications will not be considered. Resubmission of updated nominations is encouraged. <u>Nominators and nominees</u> **must be current financial members of SASB** to be eligible.

## All nominations must include:

Nominee's details: Name/phone/email/position/institution

- A statement that the nominee is aware they have been nominated
- Relevant career interruptions (if applicable)
- A response to the selection criteria (2 pages max.)
  - nominee's contribution to a relevant field of research (ECREA/MCREA)
  - nominee's leadership or synergistic activities (e.g. mentoring) (MCREA only)
  - any other relevant information pertinent to the nominee's standing in the field (ECREA/MCREA)
- A short CV (ECREA 2 pages max.; MCREA 4 pages max) not including publications
- A list of 5/10 highlighted publications (ECREA/MCREA, respectively) with a short explanation of the significance of each
- A complete list of publications (including the highlighted publications)
- Nominator's details: Name/phone/email/institution/position/relationship to nominee
